## **CONDUCT**

## **Unbecoming Conduct**

When an employee, either within the schools or outside normal duties, creates conditions under which the proper operation of the schools is affected, the State District Superintendent, upon recommendation of the State District Superintendent/designee or State District Assistant Superintendent for Human Resources/designee, and in accordance with statute, shall determine whether such acts or lack of actions constitute conduct unbecoming a school employee, and if so, will proceed against the employee in accordance with law.

Unbecoming conduct sufficient to warrant the State District Superintendent's review may result from a single flagrant incident or from a series of incidents.
