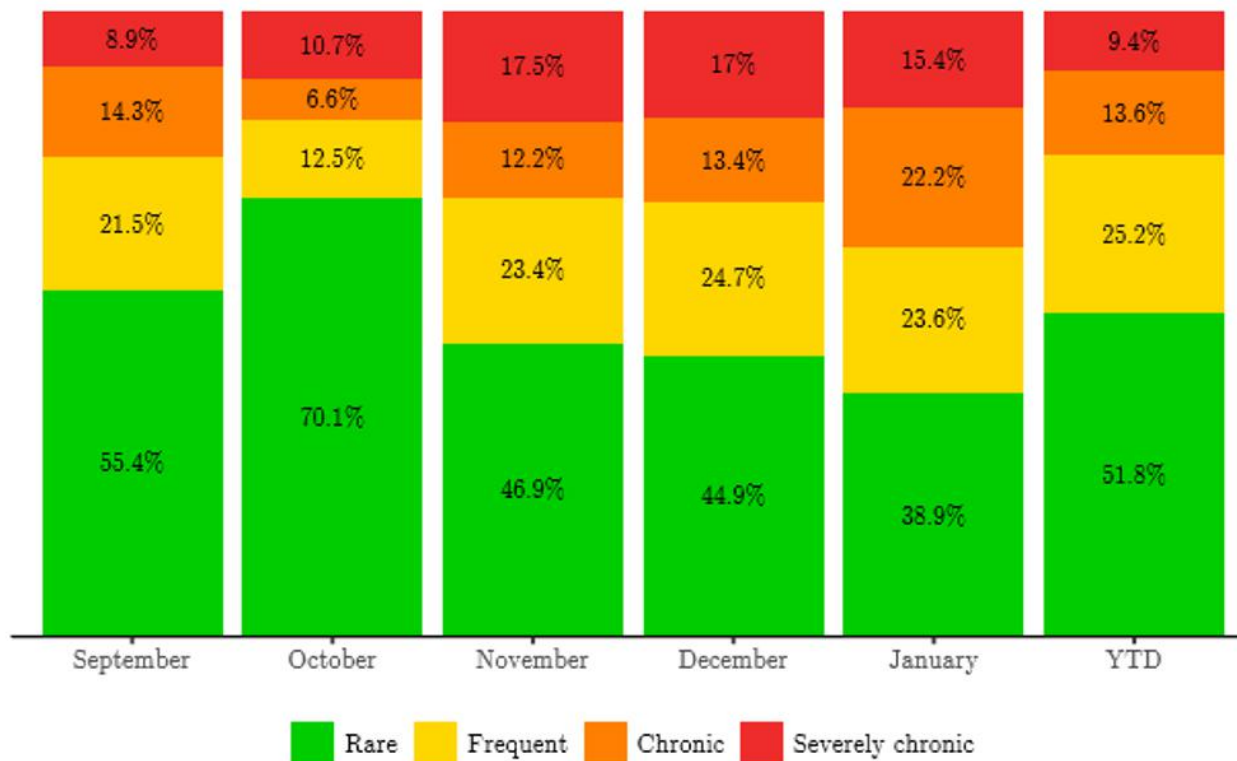

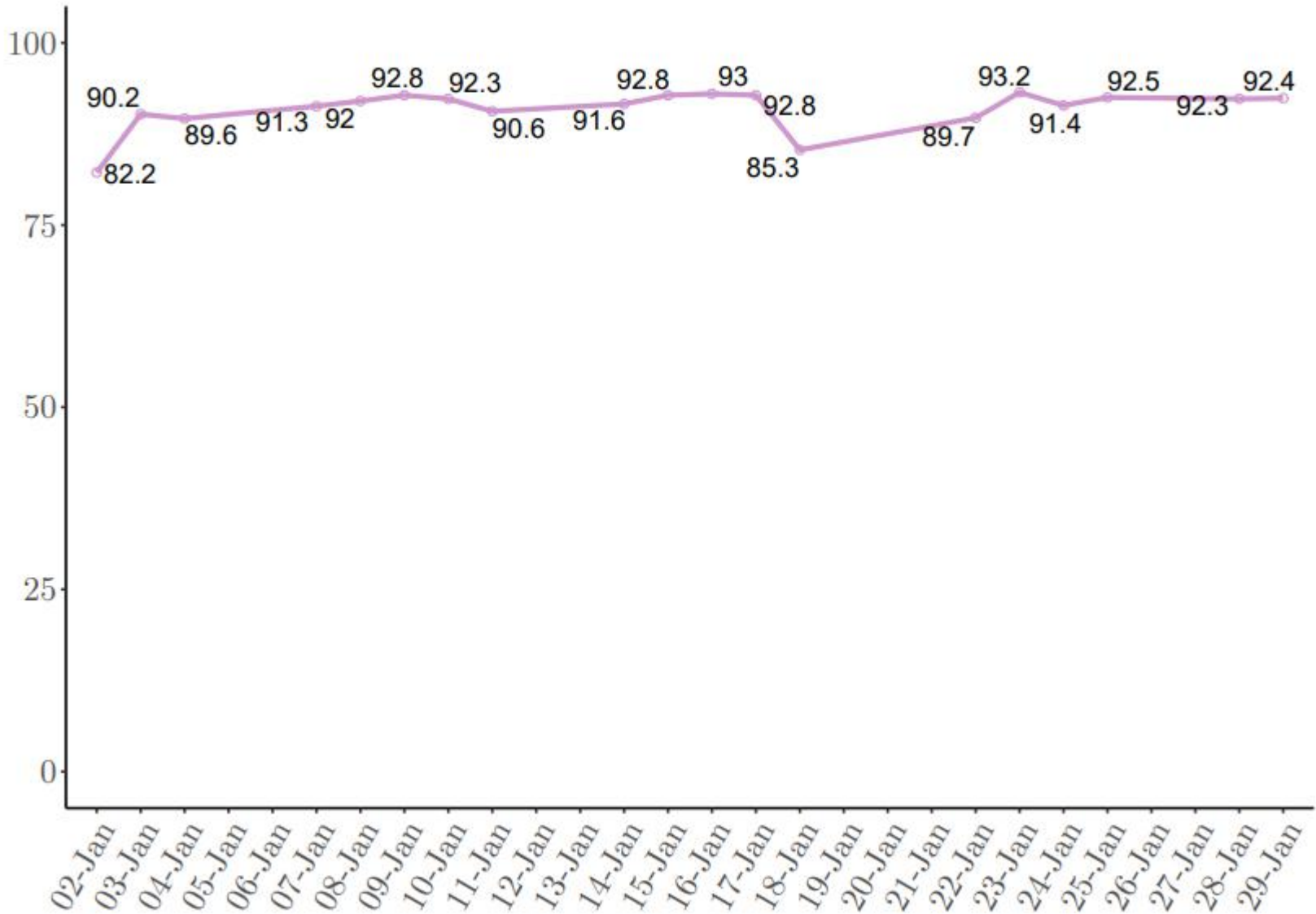

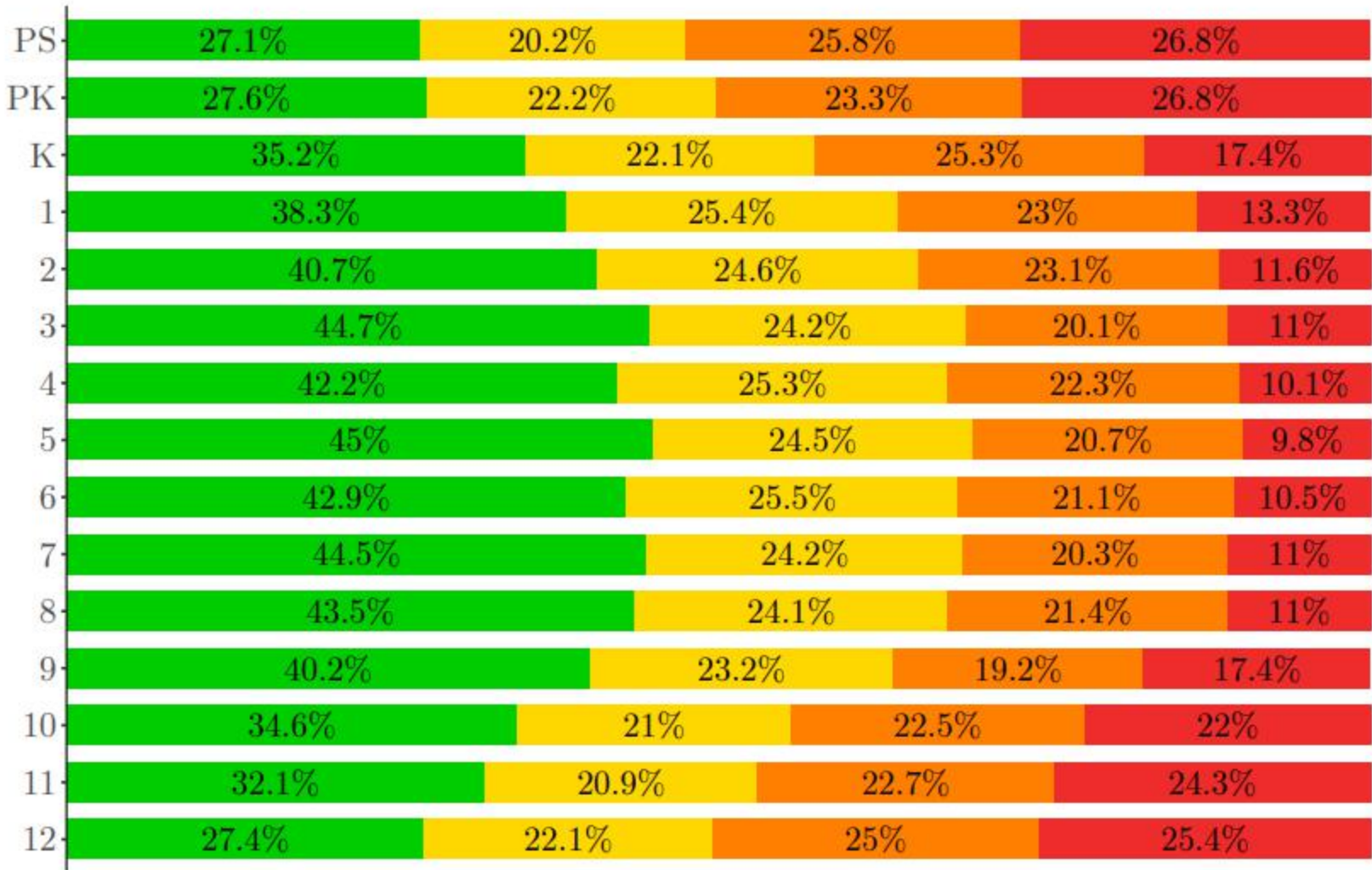
Absenteeism by Month:

# Average Daily Attendance Rate



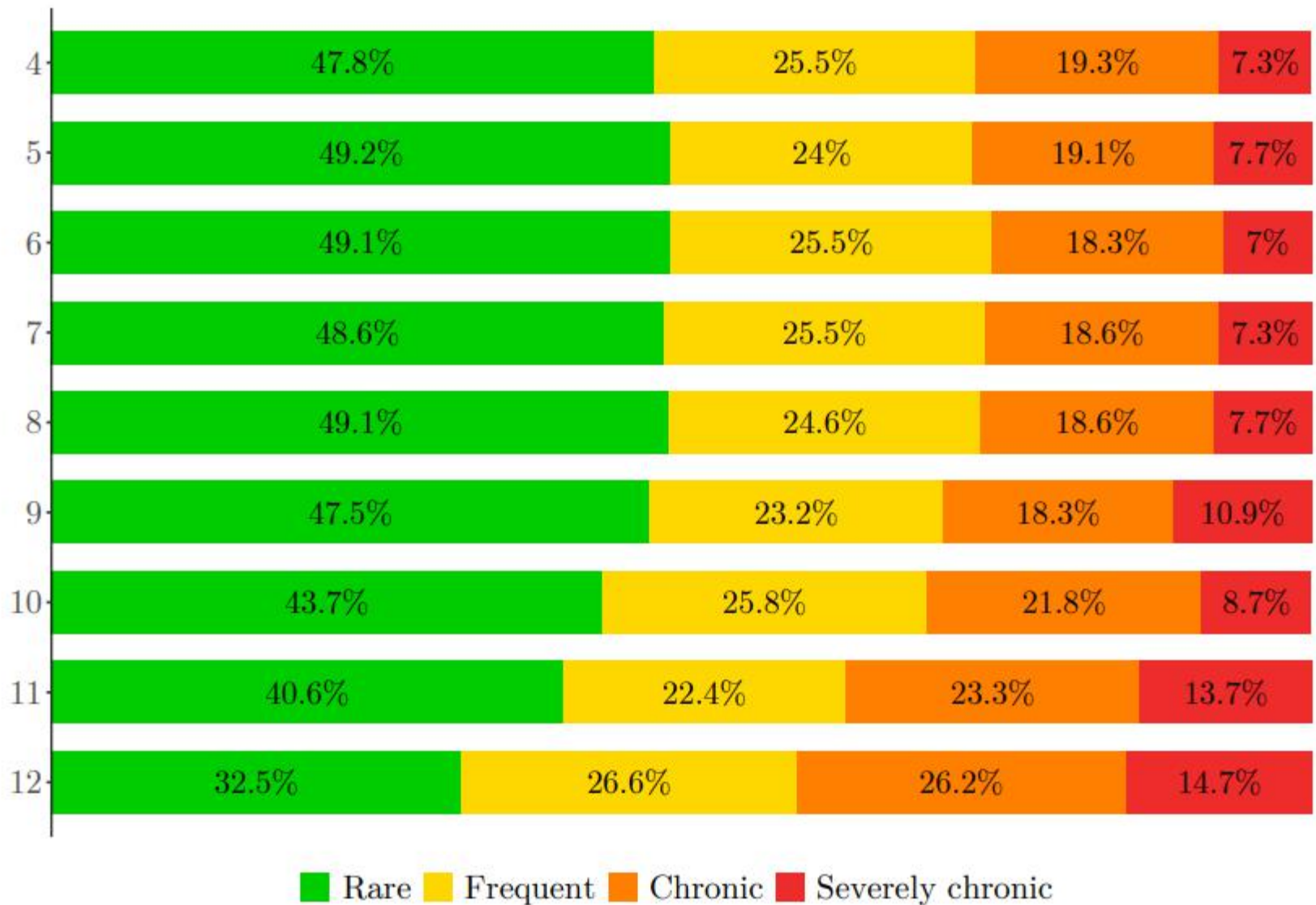
# Absenteeism by Grade by Category

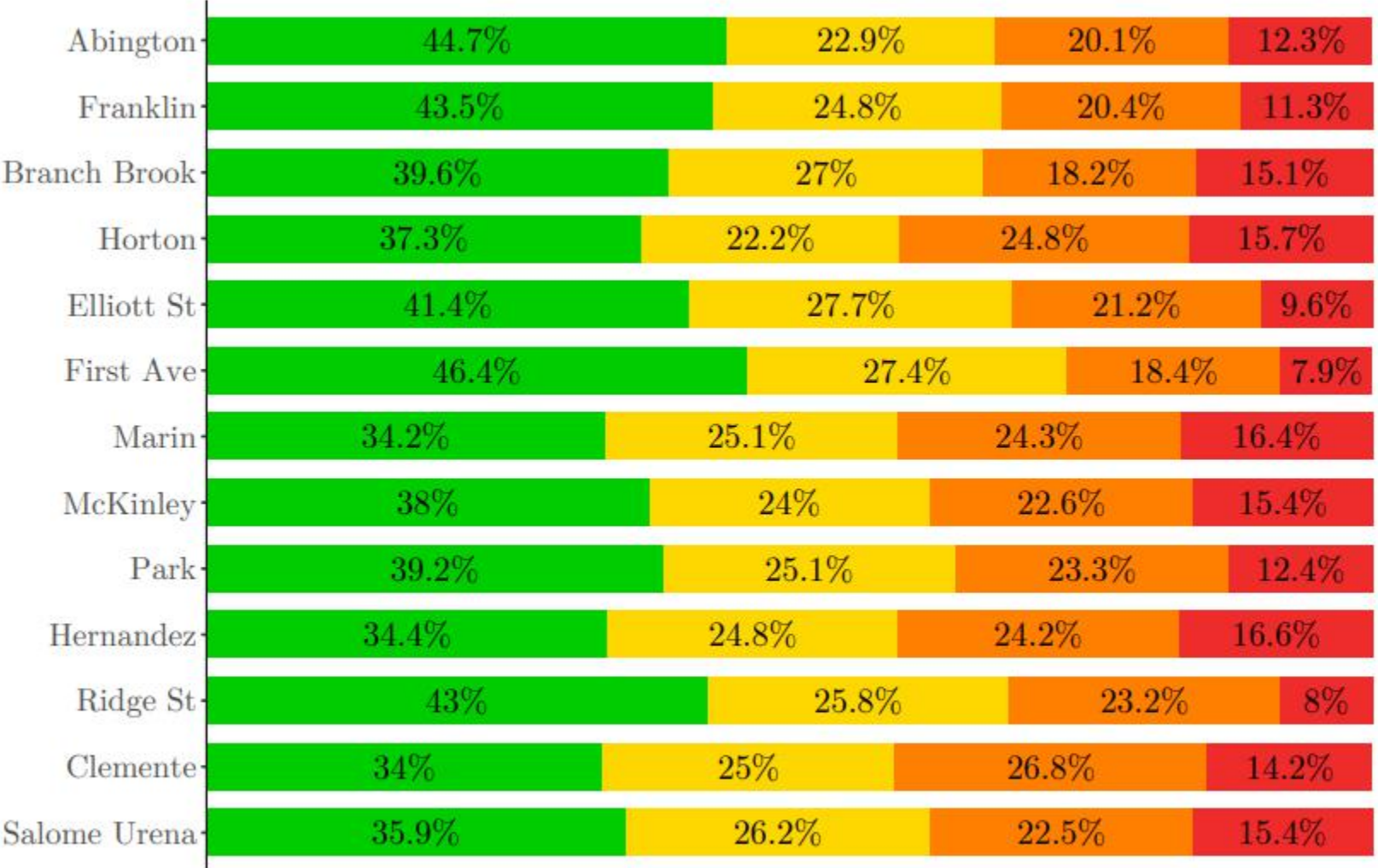


# Absenteeism by Grade by Category: PARCC-Targeted Students





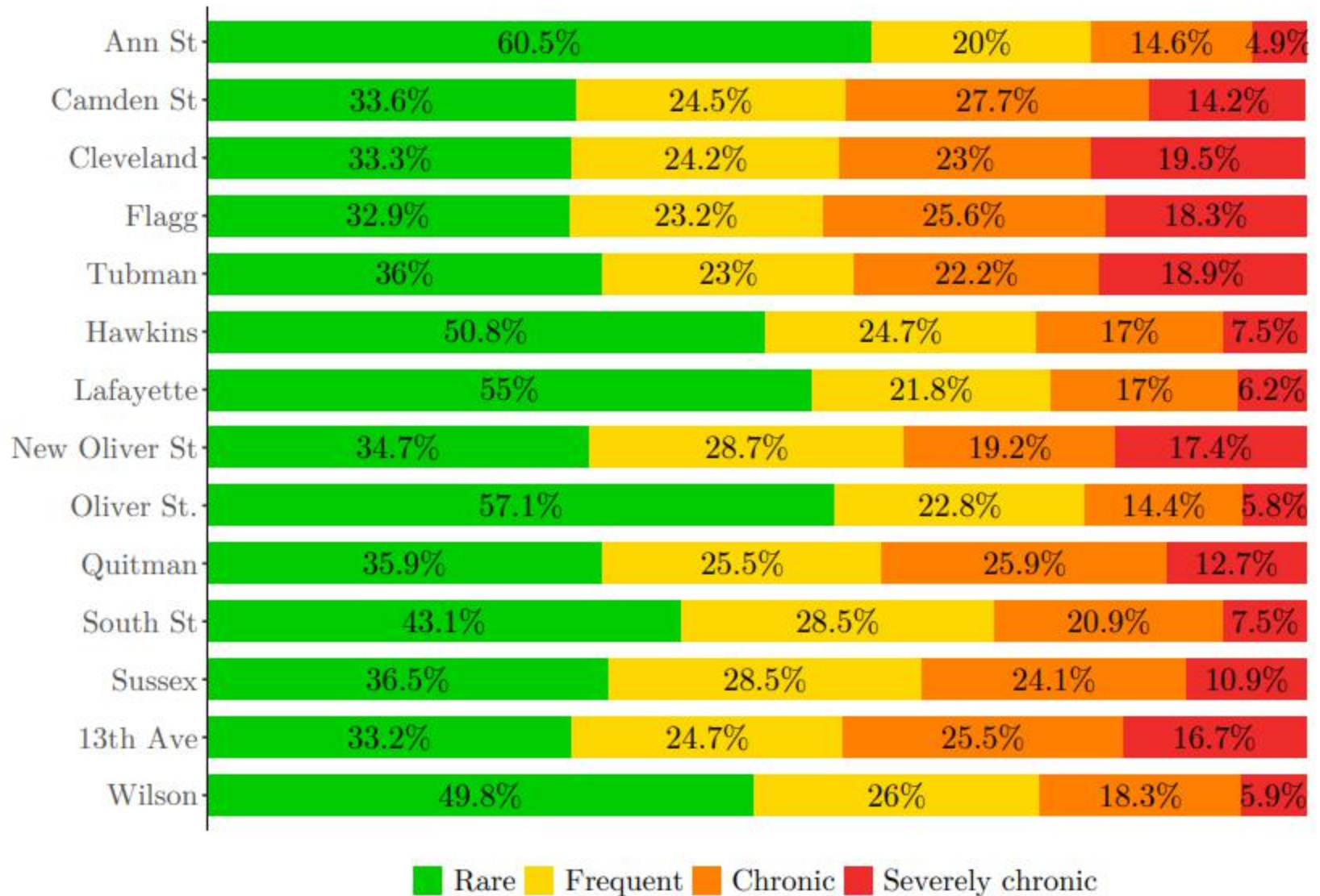
# Absenteeism by School by Category: North Ward Schools

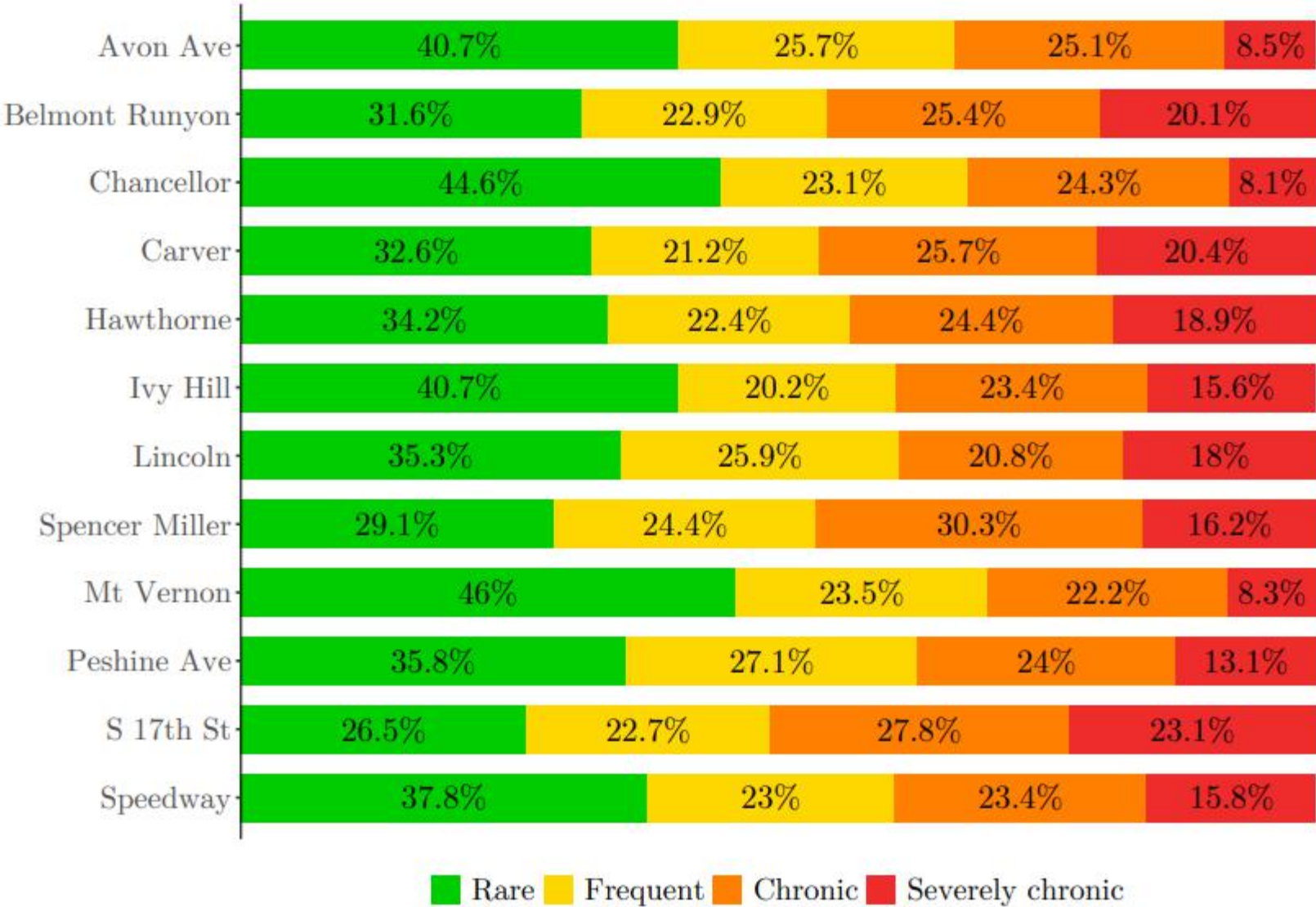


## Absenteeism by School by Category: East and Central Ward Schools





# Absenteeism by School by Category: South and West Ward Schools



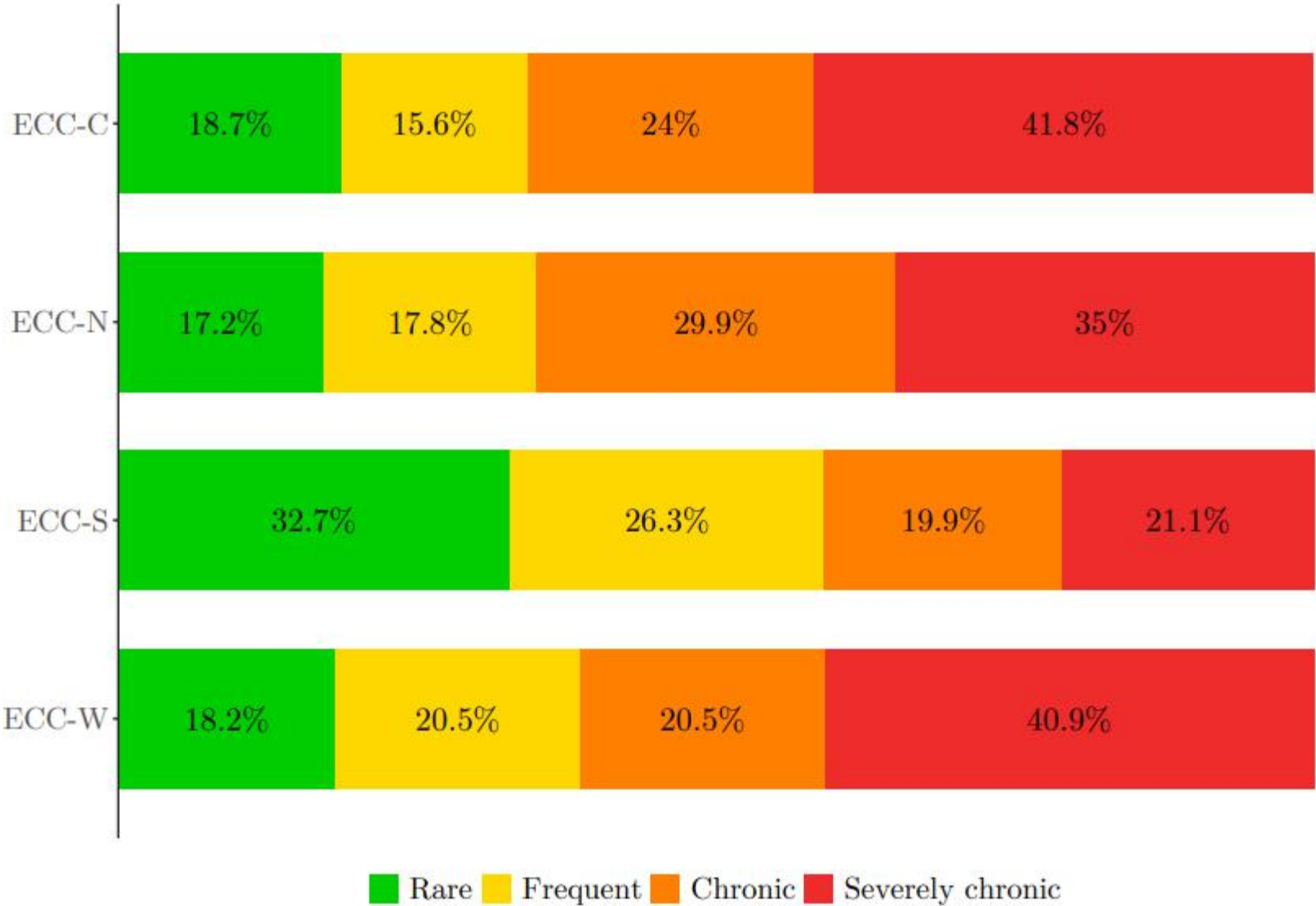
# Absenteeism by School by Category: High Schools Schools



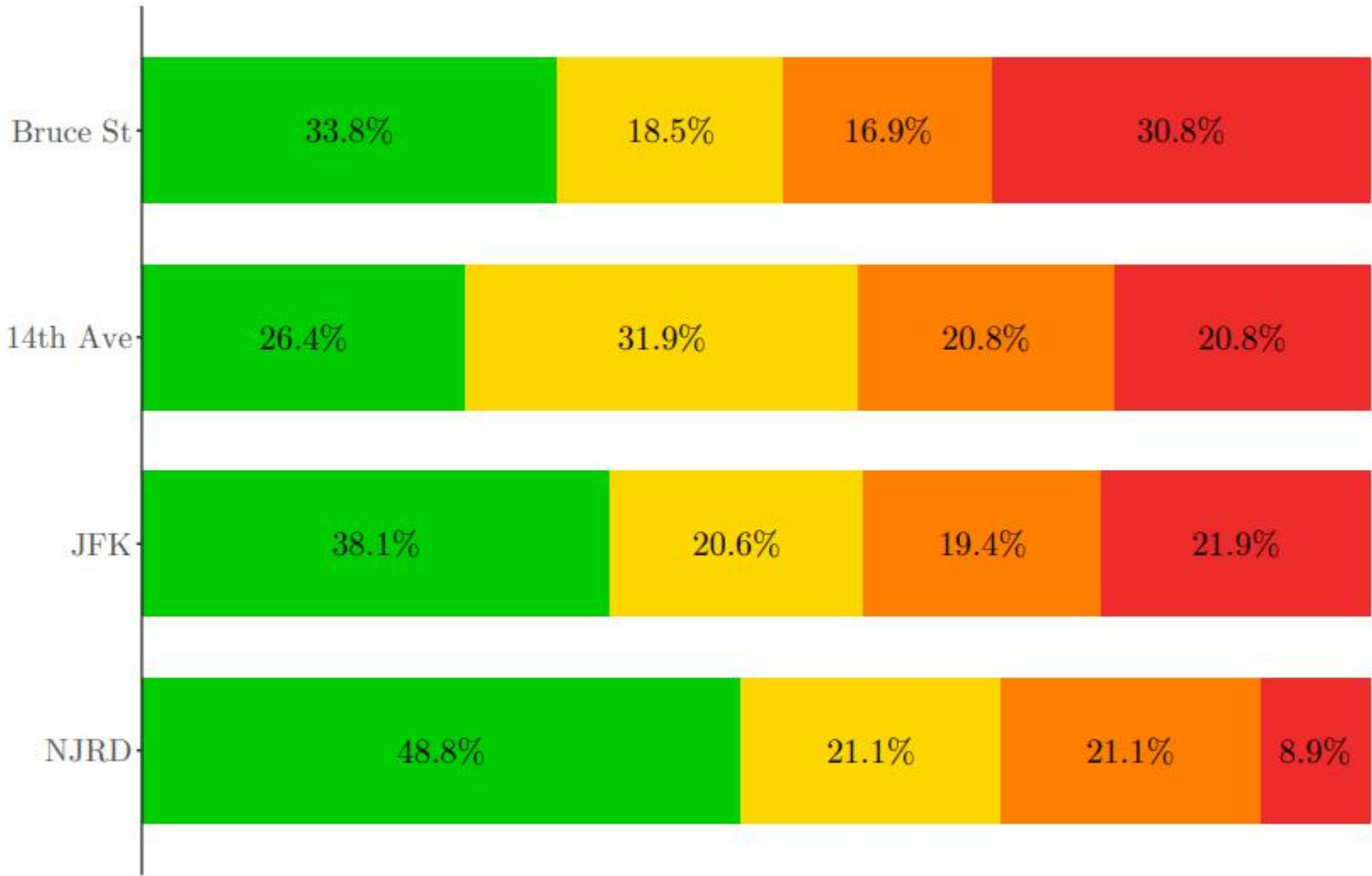
