Percussion Audition Requirements- Video AND Virtual

There are TWO important components of the percussion audition. Both requirements must be met in order to be considered for admission to Arts High School

1. <u>Required Video Submission</u>- Your video must include two parts-The **RUDIMENTS** and a **PREPARED SELECTION/SOLO**.

Be sure the video shows your entire body, including your face and hands, as well as the drum or pad on which you are playing.

Students will prepare their audition on a snare drum, or a drum pad. If, for some reason, you don't have a drum or drum pad, get creative. Use a hard cover book, or something else. If you are playing on a drum set, you are to use ONLY THE SNARE DRUM

A) You must demonstrate ALL FIVE RUDIMENTS on your video. The required rudiments

are as follows: 1. Flams

- 2. Flam Taps
- 3. Five Stroke Roll
- 4. Nine Stroke Roll
- 5. Paradiddles

Each rudiment must be played from slow to fast to slow again. There will be a demonstration video placed online for you to see how they should be performed.

B) PREPARED SELECTION (The SOLO)- Students will perform a song, of their choosing, that best reflects their ability level.

2. The second part of the audition will be a virtual part in real-time.

It will consist of an interview with the percussion teacher, as well as sight reading.

Students will be asked to sight-read a short excerpt they have never seen before. You will sign up for audition times on the Arts High School website.
