

# 2019 NORTH JERSEY BRANCH \$1,500 SCHOLARSHIP FOR HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

### **Description**

This scholarship is being offered by the North Jersey Branch of the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) to encourage students to pursue a college degree in Civil Engineering.

#### Eligibility

High school seniors who reside in the North Jersey Branch jurisdiction (Sussex, Warren, Morris, Passaic, Bergen, Essex, Union or Hudson Counties) who intend to graduate from high school in May/June 2019 and who plan to pursue a civil engineering curriculum at a college or university in the Fall of 2019.

#### <u>Requirements</u>

- 1. Minimum 3.0 (out of 4.0) grade point average;
- 2. **Completed** application (see reverse), including essay. Incomplete applications will not be considered;
- 3. 1 copy of an official high school transcript;
- 4. 1 copy of official SAT or ACT scores;
- 5. 2 letters of recommendation, not to be identical to college application letters/essays.

Deadline for submissions is March 22, 2019; late submittals will not be considered. The completed application requirements are preferred to be submitted via email in a <u>single PDF document</u> to ascenjb.scholarship@gmail.com but can also be mailed, postmarked no later than March 22, 2019 to:

#### Awards

- 1. Two scholarship recipients will be selected and notified in May 2019.
- 2. Successful applicants will be notified of their selection by the North Jersey Branch, New Jersey Section of the American Society of Civil Engineers.
- 3. The sum of each scholarship awarded for the academic year will be a maximum of \$1,500.00.
- 4. Award amounts will be paid directly to the college or university. Payment arrangements will be finalized once admission acceptance is established.
