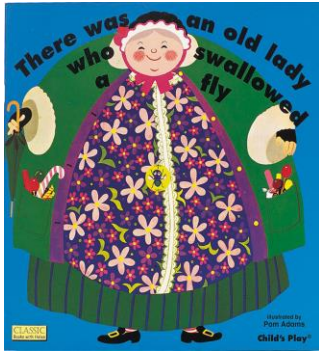


**Entering Grade K**

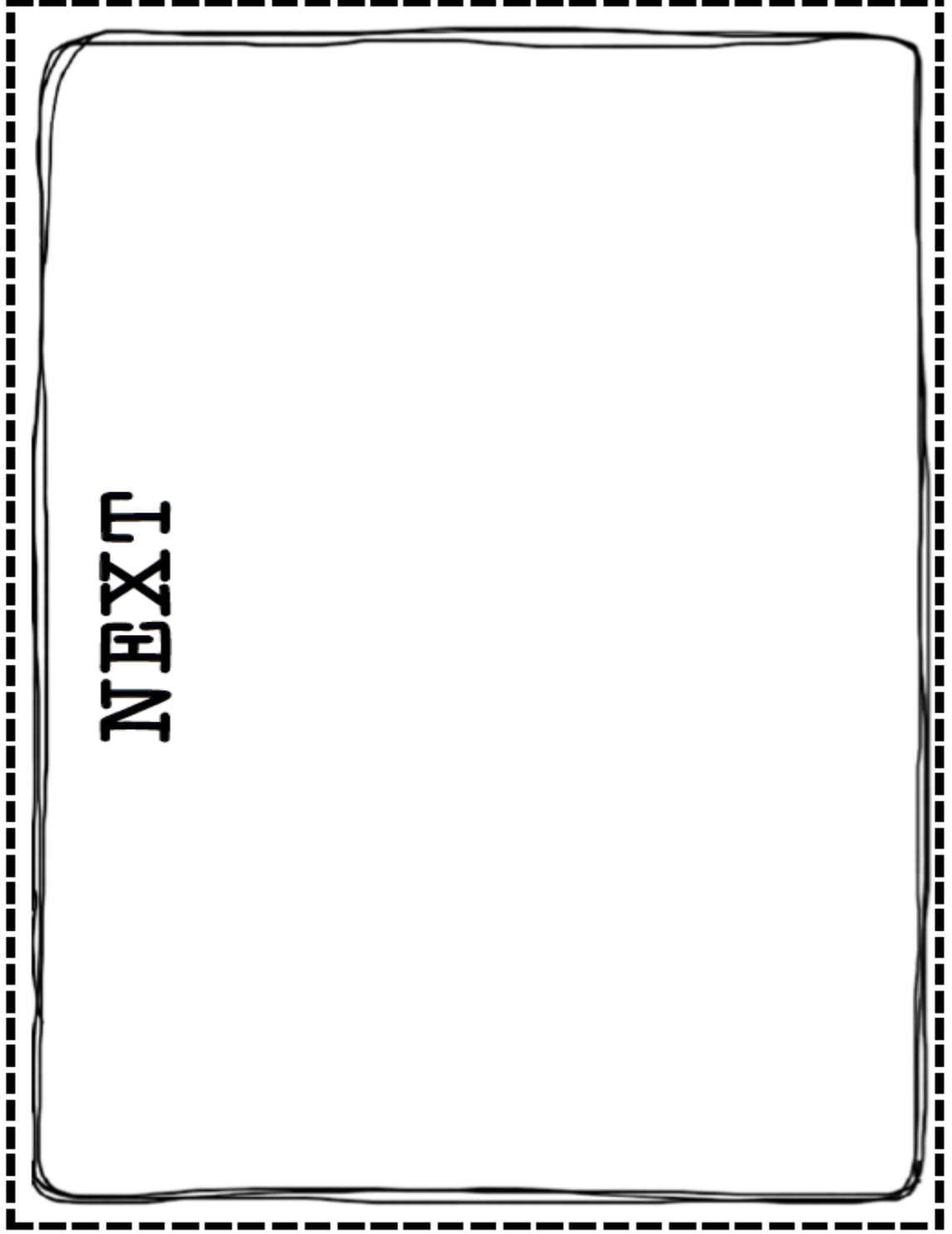
