

- See attached directions.




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BOOK # 2: *Oodles of Animals* By Lois Ehlert


ASSIGNMENT:


B. **Following Directions Activity:** Follow the 1 Step directions to color the pictures.

BOOK # 2: *Oodles of Animals* By Lois Ehlert


Create a paper bag animal using different shapes.

5. Use the paper bag animal to retell the story to a parent or guardian.


