Alphabet Letter Tracing Books

The Office of Teaching and Learning has sent letter tracing booklets to each school for students in Kindergarten and First Grade. Please make sure each student in Kindergarten receives a copy. First grade students who still need support with writing letters should also receive a copy.

Below are some guidelines for how these books can be used:

- Provide direct instruction to students on how to follow the arrows when tracing the letters.
 - Example: Letter F Start with your finger on the number one. Follow the line down. Pick up your finger and point to the number two. Follow the line across. Pick up your finger and go to the number three and follow the line across. Say "F ,/f/, fish
- Consider placing in a center for students to practice finger tracing each letter three times. Encourage students to name the letter and make the sound of the letter as they trace to help solidify sound/symbol knowledge.
