

Star Autism Supports Consultant April and May 2023

The Star Autism Supports Consultants will be returning to our district schools with Autism Programs in April for Visit 4 and May for Visit 5 at our 2 model classrooms in each school. They will provide Cohort 1 and Cohort 2 teachers with

coaching and feedback in their implementation of the STAR or LINKS Curriculum. This includes support with the use of the lesson plans, teaching materials, data systems and a curriculum-based assessment for teaching in the six curricular areas of receptive language, expressive language, spontaneous language, functional routines, academics, and play & social skills.
