• <u>K-Ready Summer Program</u>

The K Ready Program is being offered again this summer. It is an academic/enrichment program for pre K-4 students entering kindergarten in September 2021 which will run from July 1-August 6. During this whole day program students will engage in an investigation of The Five Senses and participate in rich gross motor activities in the afternoon. Lunch and snack will be provided. **The deadline for registration has been extended to Friday, May 28, 2021**. Transition

- Please review the <u>updated annual guidance</u> on compiling the Preschool Transition Portfolios. This year, a
 pre-recorded <u>Transition Portfolio Webinar</u> has been developed in addition to the written guidance to
 further support understanding of the content and expectations for electronic submission. Following
 review of the content, please complete the <u>feedback survey form</u> to ensure understanding of the
 expectations. Please follow <u>all directions</u> to fidelity.
- o SY 2020-2021 Transition Process
 - All **Pre-K 4 Students** must have a portfolio.
 - Pre-K 4 Teachers in Private Provider locations must submit their Transition Portfolios electronically through the <u>Transition Portfolio Submission Form</u> by **June 22, 2021**.
 - Pre-K 4 Teachers at District Elementary Schools should **ONLY** submit portfolios if a student is <u>transferring to a different school for Kindergarten</u> in September using the above link.

- **Pre-K 3 Teachers** will be looping and <u>do not</u> need to complete a transition portfolio. If a student is leaving the school or program, the teacher should create a portfolio and provide it to their school leader for distribution to families. **No Pre-K 3 portfolios should be submitted electronically**.
- o <u>Kindergarten Video Clips</u>
 - Due to virtual learning, many Pre-K 4 students did not have the opportunity to participate in Kindergarten tours. To address this, Newark Board of Education Kindergarten teachers are sharing some <u>video clips</u> to provide a glimpse of "A Day in the Life" of a kindergarten student. Please encourage and remind families to take a moment with their child to watch some of the videos submitted to help prepare their child to transition to Kindergarten.
- o <u>Transition to Kindergarten Workshop</u>
 - At virtual Title 1 Parent Conference in December, rising Kindergarten families were provided with information to support the understanding of the expectations of Kindergarten. Those unable to attend can still view the webinar that has been recorded in English and Spanish to support transition to Kindergarten. Please encourage families to watch the webinar and complete the short feedback form in either English or Spanish. We encourage all staff to watch the video as well.
