The Newark Board of Education Leadership Pipeline SY 23-24

Operating under the premise that the principal is the key lever of change, Superintendent León has created The Newark Board of Education Principal Pipeline, a strategy to support all instructional leaders AND produce a continuous flow of viable candidates with the capacity to cultivate school improvement and increase student achievement. To that end, during the 2019-2020 school year, the district joined a Principal Pipeline Learning Community (PPLC) sponsored by The Wallace Foundation. This PPLC supported us as we engaged in a process of self-study designed to help examine all policies, practices, and infrastructures related to school leadership, and begin planning for improvement. A Wallace Foundation representative facilitated our use of a self-study guide that contained a set of evidence-based indicators within seven principal pipeline domains and a framework for applying them. The seven domains are:

- 1. Leader standards
- 2. High-quality pre-service principal preparation
- 3. Selective hiring and placement of principals
- 4. On-the-job evaluation and support
- 5. Principal supervisors
- 6. Leader tracking systems
- 7. Systems and capacity to support and sustain a principal pipeline

During the 2020-2021 school year, the district began the implementation of a 5-year principal pipeline work plan. This plan has two goals:

- 1. To reevaluate, reassess and revise district practices associated with school leadership;
- 2. To ensure the support and development of instructional leaders, principals in particular, with the knowledge, dispositions, and skills necessary to dramatically improve student outcomes across the district.
