Cosmetology ...

Malcolm X Shabazz High School is proud to offer a licensed, state-approved cosmetology program. Students can become licensed after completing 1,000 of **engaging hands-on training** under the supervision of a licensed cosmetologist, salon owner, and certified cosmetology teacher. Cosmetology at Shabazz is a four-year program, designed with flexible scheduling to meet the required 1,000 hours for licensure. Students will sit for the state board and become licensed cosmetologists after passing the exam. The cosmetology program is free of charge to qualified Newark students.

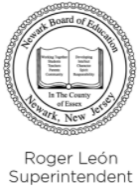
The New Jersey State Board of Cosmetology and Hairstyling Board licenses and regulates the cosmetology program at Malcolm X Shabazz. Students will learn **beauty and skin care**, hair styling, cutting, coloring, **barbering**, manicuring, and a full range of beauty and cosmetology services.

Bio-Engineering

The engineering program offers a multidisciplinary approach to teaching and learning the fundamental concepts of engineering and engineering careers. This program consists of 3 different courses that focus on solving and engaging students in challenging real-world problems. The first course focuses on the engineering design process, computer aided design and 3D printing. The 2nd and 3rd course, focuses on a broad range of engineering topics, such as mechanisms, the strength of structures and materials, automation, circuits, coding and logic. Through various projects, students explore different engineering disciplines such as electrical, mechanical and biomedical engineering
