Freshmen and sophomores enter through door 17 Juniors and seniors enter through door 4

In the event that you need to pick up your child early from school, please call the main office ahead of time so we can facilitate getting the student to the exit door. A staff member will greet you and have you sign them out. Early dismissal will not take place after 2:00 pm. Students will not be released to anyone if they are not listed on the emergency contact form which must be completed on SchoolMint. Parents/guardians must also bring a valid ID in order to pick up their child. Please do not call or text your child during times when they are in class. Cell phones are not permitted to be out in classrooms to

ensure proper focus on instruction. If you need your child, call the main office and we will get them for you.

• Safety protocols:

Exterior doors always remain closed and locked. Visitors must be greeted by a security guard using the parking lot entrance only. Regular perimeter checks are embedded into security guard schedules to ensure doors remain closed and locked throughout the day. Metal detectors and backpack scanners are used at all ingress doors. Scheduled safety and fire drills will continue to occur monthly.

• <u>Uniforms are mandatory in school</u>:

Uniform code is as follows:

School colors are yellow and purple. Khaki pants are preferred.

Black close toed shoes are preferred. Clogs, crocs, flip-flops or slippers are not permitted.

• Breakfast and lunch:

Every family is required to complete a lunch application. Applications must be completed online. Please click <u>here</u> to apply. Our goal is to have 100% of students with applications on file before the start of school. Breakfast will continue to be served upon arrival to school. Lunch will take place in the cafeteria.
