



## HIB PROGRAM & COMPLIANCE MANDATES

- **Week of Respect – (10/4-10/8)**
- **Violence Awareness (Safe Schools) Week – (10/18-10/22)**
- **School Safety Team** - Meets twice a year as part of NJDOE compliance. Meeting is designed to discuss security issues in the building, HIB trends and overall safety. HIB Specialist and security staff should be active team members. Sign in sheets and Agendas are required.
- **Training of HIB specialist** - District wide and school based personnel at individual school sites
- **Trainings** - HIB and Suicide Prevention for students, staff, and families.
- **Quarterly Reporting-** Sept-Dec/Jan-June
- **HIB Investigations** - completed within 10 days and confirmed by district ABR Coordinator.

### **Week of Respect - The Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act (P.L.2010, c.122)**

requires that the week beginning with the first Monday in October of each year **(October 4-8, 2021)** be designated as the Week of Respect in New Jersey. To recognize the importance of social and emotional learning and character education, school districts, charter schools and renaissance school projects are required to observe the week by providing age appropriate instruction focused on preventing HIB. Approved private schools for students with disabilities are encouraged, but not required, to observe this week.

**School Violence Awareness Week N.J.S.A. 18A:36-5.1** requires that the week beginning with the third Monday in October of each year **(October 18-22, 2021)** be designated as School Violence Awareness Week in New Jersey. The New Jersey Department of Education has developed Guidance for School Violence Awareness Week to help school districts, charter schools, renaissance school projects and approved private schools for students with disabilities comply with the requirements.
