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Return to Local Control

N.J.S.A. 18A:7-49(e)

 Not more than one year after return to local control, the board shall call a special election to place the question of classification of status before the voters



General Rule

N.J.S.A. 18A:12-5 & 10

Type I District – Appointed by mayor

Type II District – Elected by constituents

 All board of education members serve without compensation

- County Vocational-Technical (18)
- County Special Services (5)
- County Special Services and Vocational (3)
- Non-county based appointed boards (15)



Qualification for Office

N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1, 1.2

- Citizen & resident of the school district at least one year prior (appt. or election)
- Able to read and write
- Registered to vote; not disqualified as a voter
 - Must be 18 Years of age
- Not convicted of a disqualifying crime
- No conflicts of interest



Disqualification from Office

- Membership ceases immediately
 - Lack of in-district residency
 - Election to governing body or as mayor
 - Failure to attend three consecutive meetings
 - Disqualification as a voter
 - Conviction of a disqualifying crime



Return to Local Control – Type I

N.J.S.A. 18A:7A-49(f)

- If the voters elect to be come a Type I district, the decision becomes effective the following July 1
 - Incumbent board members at the time of election stay through the expiration of their terms & qualification of successors



Return to Local Control – Type II

N.J.S.A. 18A:7A-49(g)

If the voters elect to transition into a
 Type II district, incumbent board
 members at the time of election remain
 in office through the expiration of their
 terms & qualification of successors



Type I (Appointed) Boards

N.J.S.A. 18A:12-6, 9

- Number of members
 - 9 in <u>cities of the first class</u> or by referendum

- Term of Office
 - 3 years



Type I (Appointed) Boards Commencement of Term

N.J.S.A. 18A:12-8, 9

- Cities of the first class
 - Appointment by mayor, month of June
 - Term begins July 1
 - Terms of three years extending through expiration of appointment until appointment & qualification of successors



Type II (Elected) Boards

N.J.S.A. 18A:9-10, 12-11, 12-12, 13, 14

- Number of members 9
- Three year terms
- May increase or reduce number of members by referendum
- Annual School Election
 - April or November



Type II (Elected) Boards

Annual School Election

N.J.S.A. 19:60-1, 1.1

- Third Tuesday in April (4/16/19)
 - 14 districts, default date
 - Separate budget vote
- First Tuesday in November (11/5/19)
 - 530 districts
 - No vote on the budget at or under cap



Type II (Elected) Boards

Cost of School Elections

N.J.S.A. 19:60-1, 1.1, 12

 April Annual School Election and Special School Elections – all costs borne by the school district

 November Annual School Election – costs borne by the county; board pays any increased costs



Board of Education Organization

Type I (Appointed) Boards

N.J.S.A. 18A:12-8 N.J.S.A. 18A:10-3

- Term of office begins with organization meeting, lasts until organization meeting following last year of term
- Cities of the first class
 Appointment during June
 Term of Office commences July 1
 Organization July 1(?)



Board of Education Organization

Type II (Elected) Boards

N.J.S.A. 18A:10-3

- Term begins with organization meeting, lasts until organization meeting following last year of term
- April School Election Organization meeting occurs – 1st or 2nd week following election
- November School Election January 1-7



Type I - Vacancies

N.J.S.A. 18A:12-7

Vacancies filled by mayor of municipality

Filled within 30 days, for unexpired term

Type II - Vacancies

N.J.S.A. 18A:12-15

- Vacancies generally filled by the board
- Vote majority of remaining members of the board after vacancy occurs
- After 65 days w/o appointment, Executive County Superintendent (ECS) will appoint



Type II – Vacancies Cont...

- Unexpired terms placed on the ballot in next annual school election unless...
- Vacancy occurs...
 - April w/in 60 days of election or
 - November After third Monday in July then
 - Member serves until organizational meeting following 2nd annual election



Type I Budget Approval

N.J.S.A. 18A:7F- 5, 6 *N.J.S.A.* 18A:22- 7, 10, 11, 12, 14

- Adoption and filing of budget with Executive County Superintendent, March 4
- Executive County Superintendent approval
- Public hearing before Board of School Estimate; March 22 – March 29



Type I Budget Approval

N.J.S.A. 18A:22-1

- Board of School Estimate
 - Two board of education members
 - Appointed by board
 - Two governing body members and
 - Appointed by governing body
 - Mayor of municipality



Type I Budget Approval

N.J.S.A. 18A:22-14

- Board of School Estimate Adopt and certify budget to board of education and governing body
- Adoption at or after a public hearing before board of school estimate, but not later than April 8
- Governing body includes tax levy in tax ordinance



Type II Budget Approval

N.J.S.A. 18A:7F- 5, 6 *N.J.S.A.* 18A:22- 7, 10, 11, 12, 14

- Adoption and filing of budget with Executive County Superintendent
- Executive County Superintendent approval
- Public hearing before Board of Education



Type II Budget Approval

N.J.S.A. 18A:7F- 5, 6 *N.J.S.A.* 18A:22- 7, 10, 11, 12, 14

- Adoption of budget, including amount to be raised by taxes
- At or after the public hearing, but not later than 18 days prior to the election
- Recorded roll call majority vote of full board membership



Type II Budget Approval April Election

N.J.S.A. 18A:22-37, 18A:13-19

- If voters <u>approve</u> tax levy certified to county board of taxation by board of education
- If voters <u>disapprove</u> budget sent to municipal governing body for review
- Governing body determines tax levy



Type II Budget Approval

N.J.S.A. 18A:7F- 5, 6 *N.J.S.A.* 18A:22- 7, 10, 11, 12, 14, 32, 33

 Tax levy certified by the board of education to the county board of taxation



Change in Classification Submission of Question to Voters

N.J.S.A. 18A:9 - 4, 5, 6

- Governing body by resolution
- Board of Education by resolution
- Voter petition 15% of legally qualified voters, last general election for members of the general assembly, filed with municipal clerk or board of education
- Four year moratorium after election



Type I to Type II

Submission of Question to Voters

N.J.S.A. 18A:9 – 7, 8, 9, 10, 11

- Vote for Adoption of Question
- If approved, district becomes Type II immediately, board members remain until expiration of terms
- Next school election, increase to nine members
- 3 seats each year, 3 year terms, ASAP



Type II to Type I

Submission of Question to Voters

N.J.S.A. 18A:9 - 7, 8, 9, 10, 11

- Vote for Adoption of Question
- If approved, district becomes Type I after June 30
- New board members appointed by the mayor effective after <u>June 30</u>
 - Incumbent members terminated 18A:9-8
